

Communiqué FFVL – le 26 avril 2016

Le 19 avril 2016 l'IKO a fait un communiqué "IKO standards official recognition by IFKO" (*voir ci-dessous*).

Il y est évoqué un accord signé entre l'IFKO et l'IKO, concernant notamment les instructeurs IKO.

Bien que la FFVL adhère à l'IFKO, cet accord ne change rien à la réglementation française concernant l'enseignement contre rémunération de l'activité kitesurf. En effet, la FFVL rappelle que l'État français impose la possession d'un DEJEPS ou d'un BPJEPS pour enseigner le kitesurf professionnellement, sur notre territoire.

Pour les possesseurs de diplômes étrangers ou internationaux désirant travailler en France, il existe des procédures d'équivalence ou de reconnaissance de diplômes.

IKO Standards official recognition by IFKO.

IKO Standards are now recognized by the International Federation of Kitesports Organisations (IFKO). An official agreement has been signed on March 15th, 2016. This gives the absolute new benefit and incontestable advantage for all IKO certified members and more specifically for instructors. You can now gain legal recognition in your country if a national organization is associated to the IFKO and once an equivalency program has been defined based on the national standards in place.
